CHALLENGES AHEAD

We continue to be tremendously grateful for the support of so many each year. As with most small nonprofits, we still face new challenges despite the incredible support. Many of our challenges stem from our current economic situation. The increase in the number of working poor (the latest ALICE Report saw an 11% increase from 2019-2021), high inflation makes it very difficult for people to pay their bills, pandemic relief programs have ended, and in Greater Hartford we only have about 15% of the rental assistance and services we need to solve homelessness. The consequence of this is that our region has witnessed a 7% increase in homelessness from 2021 to 2022 and a 10% increase in unsheltered homelessness from 2022 to 2023. Despite these challenges, we are hopeful as we look ahead at this coming year, because we know that there is a growing number of people who believe in our mission, and together, with your support, we will overcome any and all obstacles to achieve our goals.
