What do we accept?

Journey Home's furniture program, A Hand Up, provides donated goods to people transitioning out of homelessness. We accept new and gently used items to furnish our clients' homes. The items we accept are modest sized, basic, and practical pieces that are needed to set-up a new apartment. We are only able to accept clean, gently used items in dignity condition.

BEDROOM

Mattresses & boxsprings

- Twin, full or queen sized
- New and like-new only (no stains or rips)

Adjustable size metal bed frames

 No bed frames with headboards/footboards
